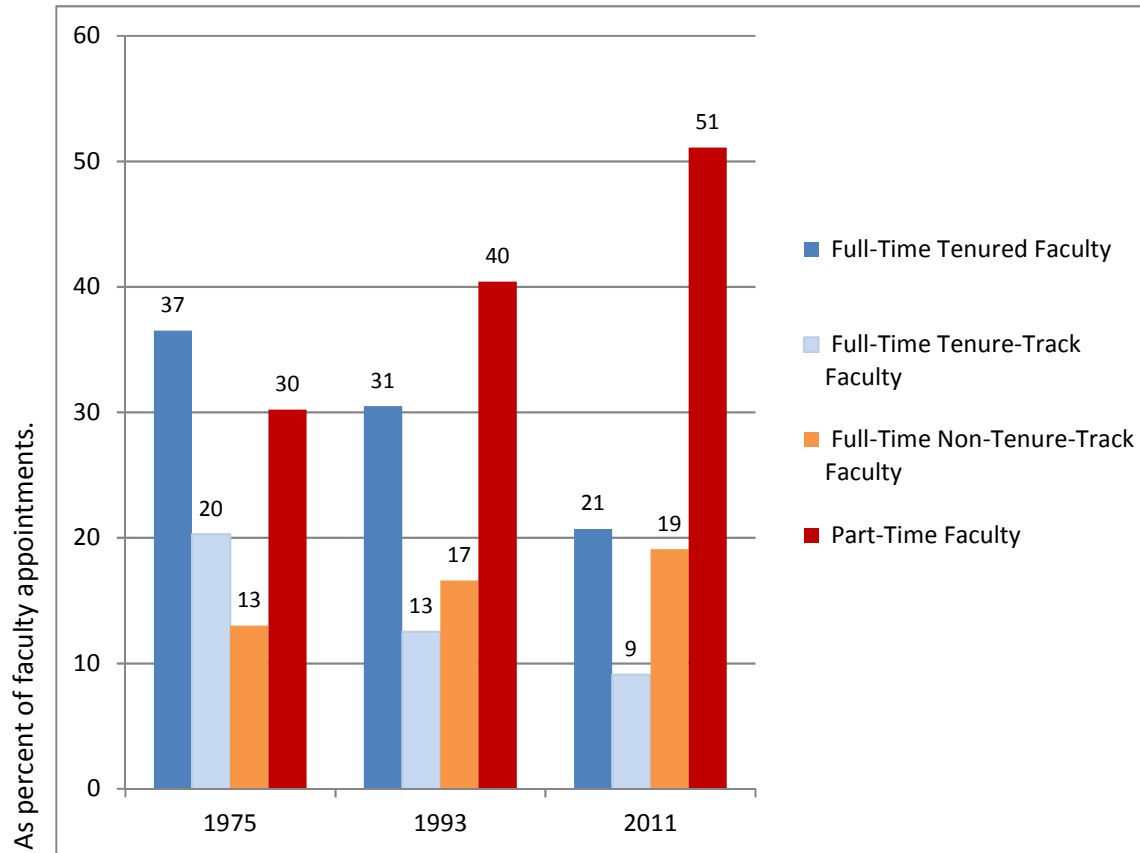
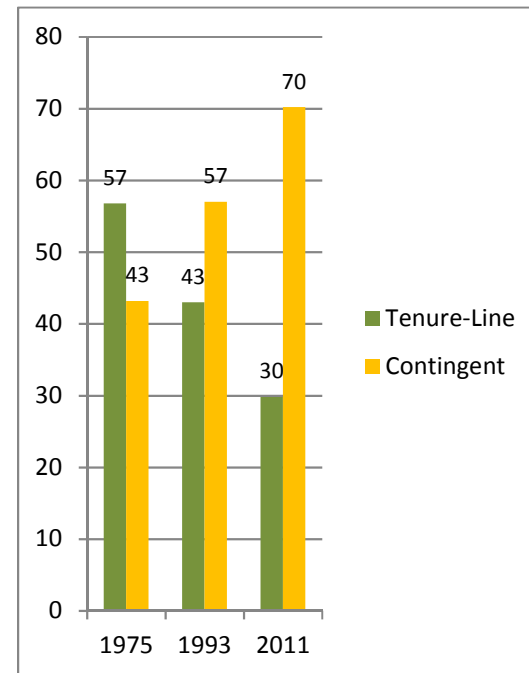


Trends in Faculty Employment Status, 1975-2011
