Institutions are placed on or removed from this sanction list by vote of the Association's annual meeting.

The publication of these sanctions is for the purpose of informing Association members, the profession at large, and the public that unsatisfactory conditions of academic governance exist at the institutions in question.

The sanctioned institutions and the date of sanctioning are listed, along with the citation of the report that formed the basis for the sanction.
