Dear Ms. Blair:

I am writing to notify you of copyright infringement under the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (17 U.S.C. § 512) through unlawfully posting content owned by the American Association of University Professors (AAUP).

1. Identification of the copyrighted work and infringing material:
